About our Speakers:

Wassia A. Khaja Ahmed, M.D.

Dr. Wassia Khaja Ahmed is board-eligible in ophthalmology and specializes general ophthalmology, cataracts surgery, and oculoplastic surgery. She completed her undergraduate training at the University of Texas- Austin in Plan II Honors program and Biology where she graduated magna cum laude. She subsequently pursued her medical degree at the Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, Texas followed by a residency in ophthalmology at University of Florida. While at the University of Florida she was appointed Chief Resident in Ophthalmology and her clinical, surgical, and research interests in oculoplastics led her to a fellowship in oculoplastics and orbital diseases under the guidance of Dr. David Kostick at Florida Eye Specialists in Jacksonville.

She has authored a number of ophthalmology research posters and publications and has presented at numerous grand rounds, journal clubs, and surgical conferences.

Kathryn B. Freidl, M.D.

Dr. Freidl is a board certified, fellowship-trained ophthalmologist specializing in glaucoma and cataract surgery. She was trained at the world-renowned Wills Eye Institute in Philadelphia, the largest glaucoma diagnosis and treatment center in the country.

Dr. Freidl is also involved in several research studies in glaucoma and is a frequent contributor to literature. Dr Freidl is one of the first in the region to perform laser cataract surgery.

S. Akbar Hasan, M.D.

Dr. S. Akbar Hasan is a board certified, fellowship-trained cornea, laser refractive, and cataract specialist. Dr. Hasan served as the lead cataract and corneal surgeon and Director of the Laser Vision Correction Program for the Mayo Clinic for ten years. Dr. Hasan has tremendous surgical experience in corneal transplantation, laser cataract surgery with premium intraocular lenses and LASIK.

Dr. Hasan provides comprehensive eye examinations for cataracts, refractive surgery (LASIK), corneal diseases such as corneal infections and scars, pterygia, dry eye, and blepharitis, diabetes, and other eye diseases. Dr. Hasan continues to engage in research, present at national meetings and publish in the peer-reviewed literature.

Dr. Amit Chokshi

A board-certified ophthalmologist, Dr. Amit Chokshi is highly trained in laser vision correction and is graduate of the University of Miami's Miller School of Medicine. After completing his residency at Vanderbilt Medical Center, where he began performing refractive eye surgery, Dr. Chokshi was awarded a fellowship at the Laser and Corneal Surgery Associates/New York Eye and Ear Infirmary, where he specialized in refractive and corneal surgery.

Dr. Chokshi went on to serve as the director of the University of Florida Laser Eye Center. He also held the positions of assistant professor and director of the cornea and external disease division at the UF Department of Ophthalmology. Dr. Chokshi is a member of the American Academy of Ophthalmology, American Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgery, the International Society of Refractive Surgery, the Tear Film and Ocular Surface Society, and the Cornea Society.

Mark Dunbar, O.D., FAAO

Dr. Mark T. Dunbar graduated from the Michigan College of Optometry at Ferris State University in 1986 and did a Fellowship in Ocular Disease at the Omni Eye Services of Lexington, KY.

Dr Dunbar has been a member of the optometric staff at the University of Miami's Bascom Palmer Eye Institute for over 25 years. He currently serves as the Director of Optometric Services and the Optometry Residency Supervisor.

Dr Dunbar is a Fellow of the American Academy of Optometry and is a founding member of both the Optometric Glaucoma Society (OGS) and the Optometric Retina Society (ORS). Dr. Dunbar also serves on the Editorial Board for Review of Optometry and currently writes the monthly Retina Quiz
